<b>Physical Education</b>  Items will be kept in the student's gym locker.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Unaltered TMS PE shirt</b> – These shirts may be purchased through our main office for \$5.00. Students may wear a plain grey t-shirt labeled with their name if they choose not to purchase the TMS shirt. Shirts are to be labeled with first name and last initial. Please bring a sweatshirt from home for colder days. Pre-purchased shirts will be distributed during the first week of the student's PE class, either 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester.</li> <li>• <b>Gym shorts/sweatpants</b> – The PE outfit should be something in which students are able to participate freely without restriction. It is important that PE clothing complies with the TMS dress code and will not jeopardize the student's health and safety. TMS PE shorts are available through our main office for \$7.00.</li> <li>• <b>One pair of athletic shoes</b> – Students will need one pair of athletic shoes to be available to be worn during PE class.
